<p>I found this issue in hg19:</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <p>copy chr5:131800537-131801093 into the coordinate window and click go;</p> <p>Then the browser shows chr5:131800537-131800982 instead of chr5:131800537-131801093.</p> <p>I also tried to modify the end coordinate(131801093) and they all go to chr5:131800537-131800982.</p> <p>See pictures for the browser shot.</p>

Now I see the problem. It is because on a wide zoom level in the browser, one pixel width of the horizontal axis spans a range of basepairs (or a bin). When browser relocates to a coordinate from text input, the landing coordinate may starts from a bin containing the original start, thus comes the small discrepancy. I will try to solve it.
